

CNA Board Meeting - February 9, 2014

Jason –

- Approximately 220 neighborhood members signed upon on NextDoor.com, which is nearly half of the neighborhood. We will need to make an extra push to get more people signed up, as it will be the most effective means of immediate communication.
- The \$6,000 borrowed from the pool will be returned, as it was not needed.
- There is a city application for a beautification grant that is due this week. We are going to apply for it. Possibly to be used for rubberized mulch for playground and garbage cans for the pool area.
- Five people have volunteered to be on the Christmas decorations/lights committee.

Brett – White neighborhood fence has been damaged in some areas from clearing of the brush and trees. Will need to be repaired.

Robin –

- May 16 and 17 will be the neighborhood garage sale. Not enough interest in fall sale.
- March 1 will be a neighborhood pre-spring gathering/get together. May post it on Nextdoor.com.
- Possibly re-open the snack shack at the pool. May do a trial for run on weekends early in the season.

Brett – Check with pool board to see if they are interested in running the snack shack.

Jason will ask Mike Schwarzel to see whether the pool board would be interested in the snack shack.

Allison

- Willow Oak may be starting a swim team that will ask to be added to our conference, which could detract from our own team. The new team may be linked to a club team.
- Would a banner announcing swim team signups at the front of the neighborhood be possible? Board members were unanimous that it would be appropriate for such a banner to be placed.

Brett –

- Would it be worth it to have an incentive for people to join Nextdoor.com? Or possibly set up a desk and catch people as they come to the pool and ask them to sign up. Matter will be researched and discussed at next meeting.

Jason –

- Tree planting in the front of the neighborhood will likely be at end of April. Need to order the trees. It would be nice if we could get enough volunteers to have each person plant two trees. City has given us enough money for the first half of the planting. The second half of city grant money will come in the fall and the second half of the planting will take place at that time.
- Swim team contract will be submitted for pool board review this week.
