Motions: All motions made by President, Josh Fain, and carried unanimously.

Pool Software Upgrade – Upgrade to full service

Pool Software Fees – Absorb all costs/pass none on to users/pool members

Membership Types – 3 Categories for Copperfield Residents, Single Adult, 2 Adults w/in the Same Household, Family Members w/in the Same Household, For Non-Copperfield Residents, only one type of membership, Non-Resident

Membership Fees- Same as last year for Copperfield Residents, same early bird special as well, Non-Resident Memberships \$650, Early bird special cut in half, \$25.00

Membership Window – Applications open Friday, March 1st, only Residents accepted initially, Non-Residents able to sign up but application not approved/accepted and no payment received, Early Bird runs from March 1st thru April 15th, Non-resident applications accepted at end of early bird window, volume based on number of resident applications, will be based on sign up order, first come first serve

Shade/Gazebos/Chairs – Strong desire for more shade/chairs, will increase as much as possible contingent upon the budget

Cornhole – Cornhole will be banned from the pool deck and all CNA property except as specifically permitted at CNA sanctioned events such as 4th of July activities, area that cornhole was previously played will have additional chairs (25 additional lounge chairs already re-strapped and ready to use) and shade structure (see above)



COPPERFIELD

Basketball/Floats – Basketball goal permitted on weekdays only and only CNA provided balls permitted for use, no inflatable floats permitted

Baby Pool – Stronger enforcement/emphasis on no children over 6 years old in baby pool, for young children not older children when main pool is on break/adult swim

Snack Shack/Popsicles – Snack Shack will reopen this season and popsicles will return, emphasis to parents to supervise children as snack shack will close again if similar issues to past seasons with popsicle liquid getting everywhere which results in ants, bees and other insects, approval to purchase another deep freeze to be kept outside of the snack shack to use to freeze popsicles before placing them in the snack shack

Pool Heater – Unable to afford, will poll pool members about increasing cost and or a one-time assessment to cover the cost, gauge interest in either option

Adult Swim/Lap Lanes – No changes to adult only swim times or lap lanes, stronger enforcement/emphasis on the ability to use lap lanes per pool rules

Banned Members – Reaffirmed the ban on two memberships previously revoked/terminated, stronger emphasis on pool rules to promote a family friendly pool, zero tolerance policy for lifeguard abuse, memberships will be revoked without refund for those that violate

Attire – No change to attire rules but greater emphasis on requiring family friendly attire

Guest Pass Purchases – Will explore ways for the pool software to accept payments/apply charges in an attempt to be a no cash facility

Clearing of Pool Deck – Pool Deck must be clear before the opening of the pool, no one and no belongings permitted to remain on the pool deck after swim team practice
